White Belt Yellow Stripe		
<b>10th Gup</b>	<b>John 3:16</b>	For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
Yellow		
<b>9th Gup</b>	<b>Romans 3:23</b>	for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God
	<b>Romans 6:23</b>	For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
Gold Belt Orange Tip		
<b>8th Gup</b>	<b>Romans 5:8</b>	But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
Orange		
<b>7th Gup</b>	<b>Acts 4:12</b>	Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.
Green		
<b>6th Gup</b>	<b>1 Corinthians 15:3-4</b>	For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures
Purple		
<b>5th Gup</b>	<b>2 Timothy 1:10</b>	but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

Blue		
<b>4th Gup</b>	<b>John 6:40</b>	For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day.

Red		
<b>3rd Gup</b>	<b>Romans 10:9-10</b>	If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.

Brown		
<b>2nd Gup</b>	<b>Acts 2:37-39</b>	When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?"  Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call."

<b>1st Gup</b>	<b>Acts 22:16</b>	And now what are you waiting for? Get up, be baptized and wash your sins away, calling on his name.
	<b>Ephesians 2:8</b>	For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God

Black Belt		
<b>School Black Belt</b>	<b>Romans 5:1-4</b>	Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God. Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope.
